Dear customers and friends of the beef industry,

I'd like to welcome you to our annual production sale on March 4, 2025 at 5:00 PM at the Fairview Sale Barn. Selling this year is a big stout set of mostly fall bulls and ELITE young females.

Our goal is to breed functional, well balanced, moderate, easy fleshing cattle for the commercial producer. We pay particular attention to breeding for maternal traits. The numbers, weights and genetics are a useless tool if you can't get cows or heifers to conceive in a timely window. The mothers of the bulls selling take care of themselves. They graze pasture in the summer, are turned out to cornstalks or cover crops for the winter months, calve, get bred back and start the cycle over again with a limited roughage diet.

Our calves who don't make bulls or replacement females are put in a feedlot and sold as freezer beef or fat cattle. We know how our cattle perform from conception to the rail and plan our breeding program around any improvements we feel need to be addressed.

Thank you for taking the time to consider using our genetics. Please don't hesitate to reach out at any time so we can assist in helping you choose the right bull or female for your program.

1770-12 DOB 9/16/23 BW 87 ADG:4.15 Use on cows

- Hooks Eagle x O'Neils Expedition (SimAngus)
- A big stout half Simmental bull who is extremely rugged. His sire, Hooks Eagle, has done great things in our crossbred program. He sires docile, moderately framed cattle with a lot of power. If you're looking for pounds in your calf crop with added thickness, look him over.



1036-4 DOB 9/04/23 BW 73 ADG: 3.74 Use on cows

- Hooks Eagle x SAV King Henry (SimAngus)
- Also sired by Eagle and out of a 15 year old cow who never misses a beat. This bull would be ideal for putting some heterosis in your female herd. Expect his daughters to be moderate framed, fertile, easy fleshing with tremendous udders who last a long time in your herd.



130-33 DOB 9/20/23 BW 82 ADG: 4.21 Use on cows

- Sitz Incentive x Cowboy Up (Angus)
- This bull, sired by Incentive, is out of one of my favorite young cows. Her mother, 5416, sired last year's top selling Barricade son, who sold to Dale Ulrich. A lot of power, rib and depth of body in this top herd bull prospect.



137-37 DOB 9/21/23 BW 87 ADG: 4.74 Use on cows

- Sitz Incentive x Stevenson Declaration (Angus)
- He is a bookend to the 130 bull. His heavy milking 4 year old dam out of Stevenson Declaration, is another very good producer. He'll sire growthy calves that are hardy. A great choice to run with a bigger group of cows with the 130 bull to sire uniform, top-end feeder calves and replacement heifers.



6126-11 DOB 9/15/23 BW 81 ADG: 5.32 Use on cows

- Mogck Entice x Musgrave Invision (Angus)
- This Entice son was the top gaining bull on test. He is extremely thick, deep bodied and seems to get better every day. Much like his sire, who has a docility EPD in the top 3% of the breed, his calm demeanor and don't care attitude, make him a joy to work with. He should add some frame to your calves as well as extra pounds with added thickness.



603-18 DOB 9/19/23 BW 84 ADG: 4.76 Use on cows

- -Sitz Incentive x Musgrave Aviator (Angus)
- -He is the second highest gaining bull on test out of Sitz Incentive. His 9 year old dam, out of Aviator, is very dependable and continues to do a great job in the fall herd. Expect him to sire soggy calves with more frame and stretch to them that grow rapidly.



701-70 DOB 11/23/23 BW 85 ADG: 3.71 Use on cows

- Square B Atlantis x Growth Fund (Angus)
- 701 is an embryo calf that has stuck out since the day he was born. He exhibits a tremendous amount of thickness from his hind quarter over his top with plenty of body length. His sire's hair shedding EPD is in the top 2% of the breed and maternal traits that have been stacked for many years.



819-108 DOB 12/27/23 BW 83 ADG: 3.6.4 Use on cows

- Square B Atlantis x Growth Fund (Angus)
- "This flush brother to 701 is the youngest bull in the offering with as much upside as anything being sold. Just like his brother, he'll sire moderately framed thick easy fleshing calves. Run these bulls together to produce a uniform calf crop and produce females that are easy keepers with tremendous udder quality.



231-62 DOB 11/19/23 BW 69 ADG: 4.34 Use on heifers

- Hoffman Thedford x BR MVP (Angus)
- A well balanced Thedford son from a very productive cow family. His
 grandmother is arguably the easiest fleshing cow on the farm out of Concally
 Cool. This bull will sire calves that come easy and gain thickness over time.
 He's a great option to retain heifers from.



227-93 DOB 12/07/23 BW 71 ADG: 4.74 Use on heifers

- -Raven Republic x Musgrave Exclusive (Angus)
- -This good Republic son is out of a first calf heifer that has a pedigree stacked with maternal greats like Thunder, Alliance, Confidence Plus and LD Capitalist. He's another great option to use on heifers to keep replacements from. They'll be moderate framed and fertile with tremendous udders.



1758-26 DOB 9/22/23 BW 81 ADG: 4.34 Use on cows

- Sitz Incentive x Granger Great Falls (Angus)
- Smooth made Incentive son who is very versatile. His maternal side is stacked with top end sires such as Final Answer, TC Stockman 365 and Hyline Right Time. Rest assured you can count on him to produce long lasting, hard working replacement females and easy doing feedlot calves.



203-10 DOB 9/14/23 BW 66 ADG: 3.94 Use on heifers

- *Stevenson Turning Point x Woodhill Broker (Angus)
- "This older fall heifer bull will have the capability to cover a few extra heifers. Calving ease on both sides of his pedigree will insure right sized calves that will be productive. Look for him to sire moderately framed offspring that are efficient.

Bulls

All bulls selling have been semen tested (see attached sheet), vaccinated with Express 5VL5 HB, pinkeye and 7 way, along with wormed/poured and have a rumen magnet. They were developed on a high roughage diet to ensure good foot quality and longevity, they're athletic, not fat. We also had them on a 70 day feed trial to collect average daily gains. Individual performance is listed by each bull's description.

Any bull purchased and taken home by the buyer from the sale barn will receive an additional \$50 off purchase price. Otherwise, we're happy to keep your bull for 60 days <u>at your risk</u>. Bulls selling for \$3,750 or more can be fed free of charge. Any others selling below \$3,750 can be housed for \$5/day.



Cows/Pairs

A tremendous opportunity to obtain some of the best and latest Angus genetics available! We continue to stand by our rule of selling females that don't settle AI or to an embryo. All of our AI'ing is done on natural heats, no synchronization programs or drugs are used to enhance heats. Our strict breeding program allows us to continually improve genetic merit as quickly as possible. The young females, many out of Sitz Barricade, have their whole lives ahead of them. Most got bred on the first heat cycle when exposed to the bull and are truly foundational. The 715 cow selling is one of my all time favorites. I've sold countless bulls out of her and have retained many daughters, granddaughters and great granddaughters in the herd. For some reason, she didn't settle AI this year and that's the only reason a cow like this would ever leave the farm. Most of the cows will have baldy calves out of our home raised Hereford herd sires. Do yourself a favor and keep their heifer calves for replacements!

The cows are on an MLV vaccination program which was done last spring. This fall they were wormed and poured and given scourguard 4KC and all were given rumen magnets as heifers.

The calves have received Boyi. Shield Gold One shot, 7 way, and given an antibiotic when they left the farm. They've been used to running on stalks so will adapt to whatever your program is.
